Westbury, New York, October 20, 2021 – We Connect The Dots announced the 'Upskill NY' Workforce Experience Program for underserved youth (ages 18-24) in partnership with the Suffolk County Department of Labor to empower them with skills for entry level jobs and career paths in technology.

The two organizations saw a clear path where they could address the region's opportunity agenda and the state of New York's strategy to reduce gun violence, providing workforce skills training and experience as well as social skill development to unemployed, underemployed, and out-of-school youth in cities impacted by gun violence. Through partnership with local community and industry partners, participants are placed in workforce experience opportunities with participating employers that can lead to full-time entry-level positions after completing the 8-week program.

This program positively affects the economic revitalization of distressed communities, reduces violent crime and recidivism, providing adequate opportunities for upward mobility, career development and advancement for low-income New Yorkers.
